Highland High School – No Summer School Program

Brunswick High School - \$150 for non residents per semester course, \$280 for full year

1st Session – June 14 – June 30, 2010

2nd Session – July 6 – July 22, 2010

Courses Offered: American & World (9th and 10th grade), Government, Physical Education, Health, Speech, Physical Science, Language Arts 9 – 12, Biology, Algebra I, Geometry

Buckeye High School – - \$250 for full credit

Credit Recovery Program in Language Arts 9 – 12 and Algebra I, Geometry and Algebra II. Course work completed on-line at student's own pace.

Cloverleaf High School - \$250 for non-residents for full credit
