WHAT KINDS OF ACTS?

This is only limited by your imagination! We are looking for musical groups (vocal or instrumental), comedy acts, dance acts, skits, etc. Your act should be well-rehearsed. Each contestant is responsible for all his necessary props, costumes, recordings, etc. The following guidelines apply:

ONLY STUDENTS IN GOOD STANDING AND WITH THEIR COACHES/TEACHERS RECOMMENDATION MAY ENTER!

Acts should be appropriate AND in good taste (NO VULGARITY).

Acts may be no longer than 5 minutes long.

Each student is required to come to the dress rehearsal with full costumes, props, and equipment.

The act that is approved and rehearsed REMAINS THE SAME for show night.

Once you have decided on an act, you must return the attached application to Ms. Turner **by Tuesday, March 11th 2:00 PM.**

Practice your act over the holiday recess for the **AUDITION** to be held on **April 10th and 11th**. Acts that do not adhere to the guidelines and policies on the following page will be cut from the show. Acts that appear to be unprepared will be cut from the show.

There is a required dress rehearsal for all selected participants. Failure to attend this dress rehearsal will result in your act being eliminated from the program.

1. ONLY STUDENTS IN GOOD STANDING MAY PARTICIPATE!
2. Completed applications and signed contracts are due on **Tuesday 3/11 by 2 P.M.**
3. Acts may NOT be longer than five (5) minutes long.
4. All Acts must be appropriate and in good taste (NO VULGARITY).

5. ***Acts must be auditioned on April 10 or 11 as they are planned on being performed.***
This includes all members of the act being present, being prepared with all equipment needed, having shown obvious preparation, and possessing and utilizing all costumes and props needed for the act.
6. ***There will be a required dress rehearsal on May 15th from 3-7pm.*** Failure to attend this dress rehearsal will result in your act being eliminated. **DO NOT APPLY TO BE IN THIS SHOW IF YOU ARE NOT AVAILABLE TO DO THIS.**
7. No changes may be made to an Act after the audition process is over.
8. All auditions and rehearsals are CLOSED (meaning no friends/family will be permitted in the auditorium during audition and rehearsal times)
9. You must provide your own equipment and arrange for transportation of it.
10. **All scripts, lyrics, and spoken words must be submitted in writing at the time of audition.**

We, the undersigned, understand and agree to the guidelines and policies established by the Highland School District and Highland Yearbook Committee. We understand that failure to abide by these policies may result in my act being eliminated from the program or disciplinary action as appropriate to the offense.
